June 20, 2019

Roxi brought the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Agenda: Stood as presented.

Nominating Committee: The Council wasn't completely sure the status of nominations for Council replacements as Pastor Dan had been leading this up. Roxi will follow up with the Nominating Committee.

Jon Weston agreed to help the new members of the Finance Committee until they're comfortable with handling the reporting on their own. Bob Weston agreed to do the same with the Trustees.

Budget: Jon shared that giving is getting better; however, we are still showing a deficit. He noted that is necessary to use the New Light rental income for general budgeting purposes. He also noted that summertime historically has been a difficult for donations.

The Building Maintenance Fund, not the general budget, has been accessed for updating the parsonage.

Security Door: Bob reported this should be installed in mid-July.

Parking Lot Repairs: Bob is still waiting for additional bids and information. We received a bid from Seal Tech that needs to be confirmed. The Trustees will gather more information before an approval of the expenditure can be made.

Hallway Flooring: Bob received bids for replacing the carpet in the education wing; however, the bids are now dated and will need to be redone. The office will be included in the bid request. It was suggested that we install a laminate rather than replace the carpet, due to wear and tear.

Meet and Greets with Luke and Bethany: These events still need to be scheduled. It was noted that if you host an event they do not need to take place in your home. It was noted that child care may need to be found, dependent upon the place and time. Twila and Roxi will coordinate.

Summer Bashes: These are scheduled for June 26, July 24, and August 25. It was noted there is a great need for volunteers for these events.

Roxi closed the meeting with prayer. Meeting adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
